



Isaac frequently arrived to his fiddle lessons in camo and sleeveless work



Llano dearly misses our friend, and we are proud to honor Isaac through this annual Memorial Fiddle Award.

THE GIMBLES



The Gimbles consists of the 2nd and 3rd generations of a legendary Texas music family. Dick is the son of the iconic Johnny Gimble. Johnny is considered to have been the finest fiddler to ever play with Bob Wills, the King of Western Swing.

Playing alongside his father for five decades, Dick accessed the kind of musical knowledge and nuance that only such a relationship can impart.

Third-generation Emily has continued the tradition by performing with both men for over two decades, but also by working with her contemporaries to recharge the music.

The Gimbles is a mix of Western Swing, Swing standards from the 30's & 40's, some honky-tonk and country blues, and a healthy sampling of Johnny's own beloved compositions. Emily and Dick perform as a duo, but also in trios with one of Johnny's notable disciples, including such accomplished fiddlers as Wes Westmoreland, Jason Roberts, Randy Elmore, Katie Shore and Warren Hood.

Dick has been a music professor at McLennan College for 39 years, and has conducted hundreds of workshops on swing music: improvisation, rhythm section, record production, etc. With his father, he pioneered the Johnny Gimble Texas Music Camp. Emily has taught vocal workshops at music camps and festivals throughout the country. A residency with The Gimbles could range from such workshops as those above to weeklong, community-wide educational presentations and mini-performances.

Fiddle Appreciation at the Llano County Historical Museum

Preserving and interpreting the history of Llano County are among the chief goals of the Llano County Historical Museum, and this includes musical history. Llano County has produced some outstanding fiddlers throughout the years, and a new crop of

young fiddlers is in development, as evidenced by the number of young local musicians participating in the Open Fiddle Contest during Llano Fiddle Fest.

Llano Fiddle Fest has partnered with the Llano County Historical Museum for several years to develop a permanent display in the museum,



featuring instruments and biographical sketches of Llano County fiddlers of days past, such as Otis Light, John (JC) Burton, Woodrow Thomas and Eddie McDonald. Also on display are news clippings and memorabilia from past years of Llano Fiddle Fest. In 2022, the collection was honored to add the fiddle of Hugh Farr (1903-1980), who was

born in Llano County and played with The Sons of the Pioneers from the mid-1930s through 1958.

On Sunday morning, museum volunteers will prepare and serve biscuits, sausage gravy, and all the trimmings for a hearty brunch following a brief church service and music by The Gimbles.

Breakfast is by donation, with proceeds benefitting the Llano County Historical Museum.



Billy Mata & the Texas Tradition

With over 40 years of music making, Billy Mata & The Texas Tradition bring their authentic Western Swing to dancehalls all across Texas, with true traditional country music. Billy started his recording career in the 1970's, singing Billboard charted, Top 40 Country music. He has been named Academy of Western Artists Western Swing Vocalist of the Year three times, and has received the Academy's Entertainer of the Year Award.

Billy's career started as a featured singer with Tommy Morrell and the Time Warp Top



Hands on Larry Scott's syndicated radio show, The Lincoln County Cowboy Symposium of the Air. That lead to guest appearances with the Texas Playboys, featuring Tommy Allsup and Leon Rausch. From there, Billy was invited to perform at the West Texas Western Swing Festival in Snyder, Texas and following that, at the Lincoln County Cowboy Symposium in Ruidoso, New Mexico, where he is now invited to entertain annually. He has gone on to become the heir apparent to the Bob Wills tradition as the Voice of Western Swing.

True to his Texas heritage, Billy insisted on recording his 1998 album *Keepin'*The Tradition: A Tribute to My Heroes with his own stage band, to properly perform the music he truly prefers: real Bob Wills Western Swing and Traditional Country. His instincts proved true, with the album winning multiple awards and his music getting further radio exposure. By the time his two subsequent albums were released (*Traditionally Yours* in 2004 and *Domino Effect* in 2006), Billy was a radio hit. Billy Mata & The Texas Tradition has

enjoyed regular rotation on SIRIUS/XM's Willie's Roadhouse and worldwide traditional country radio stations.

In 2008 *This is Tommy Duncan, Volume One* was released. The first of a Trilogy Tribute to the "Voice of Western Swing," it includes guest appearances by historic patriarchs /creators of the Western Swing phenomenon. Designed to bring attention back to the Bob Wills vocalist, Tommy Duncan, who lived in the shadow of the king, the album was awarded the 2009 Western Swing Album of the Year by the Academy of Western Artists.

This is *Tommy Duncan, Volume Two*, featuring the years of Tommy Duncan's own band, was released in the Spring of 2011, continuing the Trilogy.

In 2012, just one year after *Volume Two* was released, Billy released *By Request*, a special collection of the most asked for Western Swing and Traditional Country Honky-Tonk Dancehall songs at Billy Mata live performances.

This is *Tommy Duncan, Volume Three* was released in January 2018. This is the final chapter, covering Tommy Duncan's return to Bob Wills and his Texas Playboys. *This Is Tommy Duncan, The Trilogy* is now complete.

Billy Mata and The Texas Tradition's music is not just limited to Texas. The band has performed throughout the United States, Canada and Europe.

The Texas Tradition is a handpicked collection of professional musicians from a wide area of Texas who are gathered together by their common interest in Western swing and the opportunity to play with the best of the best. They play like family. Together, they aren't just another "human jukebox" on the stage. When they play, it's natural and fun. Bob Wills knew how to do this. Tommy Duncan knew it. Billy Mata knows it. The audience gets the reward of it.

Joseph Reuben Johnson 1879 — 1961

My maternal grandfather, Joseph Reuben Johnson, was a fiddle player. He was born in Williamson County, Texas; moved with his parents and siblings to Buffalo Gap in Taylor County; and finally moved to the Valley View community in Mitchell County, where he and my grandmother raised two daughters. Some of his siblings also played musical instruments. I was born too late to hear the family band, and I have a vague memory of hearing my grandfather play the fiddle only once. His daughters arranged for some musicians to come to his home to play for him shortly before his passing. I can only imagine how important music was to him and his brothers and sisters, who experienced the hard work

and hard times that were common to farm families. His fiddle occupies a place of honor in my home. — *Marilyn Hale*
